ABOUT OUR HISTORY

In the mid-1950s, a group of young Catholic professionals from Santa Fe began to conceive the idea of a Catholic University. On June 9, 1957, the Archbishop of Santa Fe, Msgr. Nicolás Fasolino, founded the Instituto Libre Pro-Universidad Católica de Santa Fe, opening its doors with degree courses in History and Literature, and schools of Architecture and Economics, in the building located at 1966 San Martín Street.

With the Recognition Decree of University Status, dated August 15, 1960, was granted to issue degrees and diplomas under the name of Catholic University of Santa Fe. After a decade of operation and growth in both students and professors, the "adventure of the new campus" began, which would end with the relocation in 1971 to the current building at 7151 Canónigo Echagüe Street.

Institutionally strengthened, over the following decades the Catholic University of Santa Fe undertook a process of territorial expansion, starting its activities in the cities of Posadas (1985), Reconquista (2000), Rafaela (2005), and more recently, in Gualeguaychú (2012) and Rosario (2014).

This growth was not only geographical, but the UCSF also consolidated its academic proposal by incorporating degree courses such as Bachelor of Social Communication and Industrial Design, as well as creating new academic units such as the Graduate Department (1992), the Faculty of Psychology (2007), the Faculty of Health Sciences (2012), and the Faculty of Agricultural Sciences (2013), the latter located in Reconquista city.

Since the year 2000, the University has carried out two institutional evaluation processes, also obtaining accreditation from CONEAU for all degree courses currently subject to this requirement. These instances have helped to enhance the extensionist vision of the University and its committed integration with the community, for the development of the Common House.

Under this perspective, the Technological Linkage Unit (UVT) was created with the purpose of promoting research and technology transfer with productive activities and the business world.

The digital revolution and the development of the internet, through the Institutional Distance Education System (SIED), explore and take advantage of the possibilities offered by technology in pursuit of a better learning experience. As a result of this work, the University now offers 100% digital proposals to access quality training from anywhere in the world, in undergraduate degree courses and bachelor's degree cycles.

Through a broad proposal in undergraduate, graduate, and postgraduate programs, fostering research and extension through the UCSF Researcher Career, and with strong ties and integration with the community, UCSF manifests itself as an academic-scientific community, where enthusiasm is its driving force, creativity its method, and projection its goal.

RESEARCH AND EXTENSION

From the Secretariat of Science, Technology, and Extension, the university promotes, coordinates, and organizes research and extension proposals.

Being Research one of the fundamental pillars of the university's social function, through the various institutes and annual calls, scientific work is promoted among university teachers, students, graduates, and professionals.

In the same way, the Extension function, as the one that promotes the link with society, is developed through the Technological Linkage Unit, the research projects and academic chair extension, the institutes and the specific actions promoted from the academic units and Rectorate.

With the aim of strengthening and optimizing the R&D function, the UCSF Researcher Career was developed as a tool to further enhance research in the academic field, increasing the number of researchers, articulating linkage actions with all university campuses and promoting international cooperation for research and development projects.

VIRTUAL EDUCATION

Since its inception, our University has been based on an educational, academic, and institutional model where the education offered is one and unique, and where the choice between face-to-face or virtual pedagogical options that is adopted is not exclusive, but rather articulated and complemented to enhance and enrich it.

We believe and focus on the idea that distance education is not the absence of presence, but on the contrary, it is the presence of the human being in its fullness, mediatized by a virtual option that qualifies it.

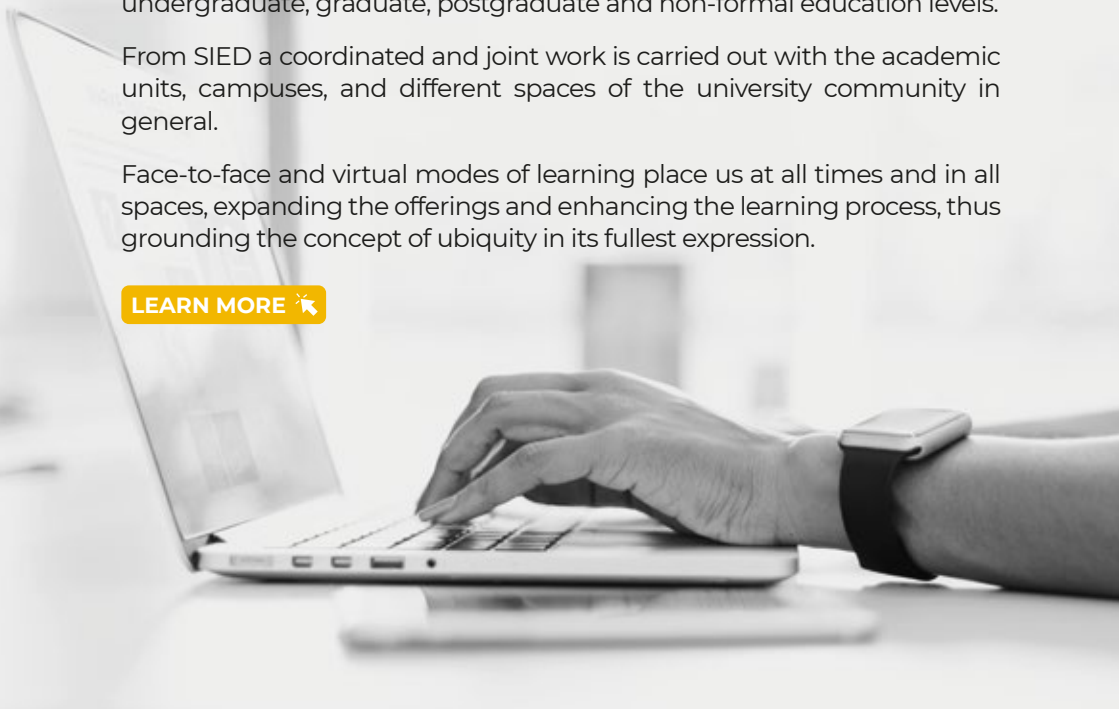
The flexibility of teaching, learning, communication, and evaluation environments promotes other forms of relationship and interaction between university professors and students, encouraging the creation of collaborative learning as hallmarks of virtual environments.

Thinking about the University in these times requires also thinking about it from the virtuality and from the connection from another place with the entire community, close and not so close. Convinced of this, we accredited our Institutional Distance Education System (SIED) before CONEAU, which systematizes, executes, and supervises all the training proposals that are carried out through the virtual campus, totally or partially, at the undergraduate, graduate, postgraduate and non-formal education levels.

From SIED a coordinated and joint work is carried out with the academic units, campuses, and different spaces of the university community in general.

Face-to-face and virtual modes of learning place us at all times and in all spaces, expanding the offerings and enhancing the learning process, thus grounding the concept of ubiquity in its fullest expression.

OUR PROFESSORS

Teaching at the university level requires continuous improvement in teaching practices for the benefit of students. UCSF promotes the strengthening of all its professors through the Teaching Career and the Categorization System, which allows for ongoing self-evaluation and the proposition of career growth strategies.

The Pedagogical Advisory Undersecretariat promotes and develops activities for the continuous training of university professors in the teaching-learning processes at the higher education level. At the same time, it accompanies the different academic units in the accreditation processes of careers and institutional self-evaluation.

The University, in its various campuses, has equipped spaces for the development of specific practices in different fields of study: Simulation Courtroom Classroom, Multimedia Complex, Gesell Chamber, Architecture and Industrial Design Workshops, Audiometric Booth, Mobile Veterinary Teaching Unit (UMEV), and Laboratories, among others.

From the Tutoring Area, a space for orientation and assistance is offered to students during their university life. For this purpose, it has counselor professors in all campuses, whose goal is to accompany students in their personal growth and integral development.

Libraries System

To achieve this, it actively participates in different events and fairs, local, national, and international, related to the editorial production. At the same time, the UCSF Publishing House works and establishes cooperation links with other university presses through its participation in the Private Universities Publishers Network (REUP), a network born within the framework of the Council of Rectors of Private Universities (CRUP).





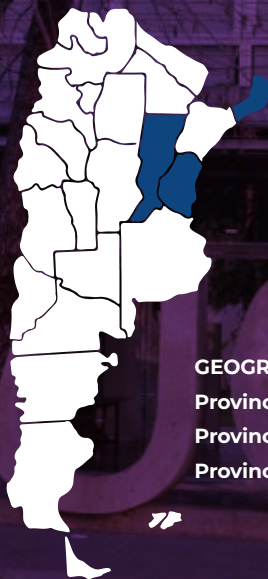
UNIVERSITY WELFARE
